## SUMMER 2009 ANATOMY AND PHYSIOLOGY COURSE INFORMATION (A&P I AND A&P II)

**CLOCK HOURS:** Anatomy and Physiology I: 80 Hours Resident Training  
 Anatomy and Physiology II: 45 Hours Resident Training

**RESIDENT TRAINING:** A&P I: July 22–26 (break 1 day) July 28–August 1, 2009 (8:00–17:00 Daily)  
 A&P II: July 28–August 1, 2009 (8:00–17:00 Daily)

**LOCATION:** Resident Training is held at the Kongress & TheaterHaus and the Pfaarheim, Bad Ischl, Austria  
*(Because of the nature of the intensity and complexity of Resident Training, we strongly recommend that students stay on campus at the hotel for Resident Training.)*

## COURSE COSTS (Please check the course for which you are registering)

**Tuition:**  A&P I – 2,800.00 (U.S.)  A&P II – 1,600.00 (U.S.)

**Textbooks:** Approx \$125.00 (U.S.)

## SUMMER 2009 CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

- The tuition for the Summer 2009 Anatomy and Physiology I course is \$2,800.00 (U.S.), and for the Summer 2009 Anatomy and Physiology II course is \$1,600.00 (U.S.). Tuition includes 10 days of Resident Training for A&P I, and 5 days of Resident Training for A&P II. It does not include room, meals, or outside personal process work.
- A \$1,400.00 (U.S.) (A&P I) or a \$800.00 (U.S.) (A&P II) deposit is paid upon applying to the program and must be postmarked and/or received by June 15, 2009.
- The balance of the tuition that is due must be received by July 15, 2009 to avoid being charged a late fee.
- Your deposit will be refunded if you are not accepted. If you are accepted into the program and find that you are unable to attend, \$1,000.00 (U.S.) of your A&P I tuition deposit or \$500.00 (U.S.) of your A&P II tuition deposit will be refunded to you if you notify the school by July 1, 2009.
- **After July 1, 2009, all monies paid are nonrefundable.**
- If you withdraw your application within three (3) business days after the date of the Enrollment Agreement and payment is accepted by the school, up to 75 percent (USD) of your tuition deposit will be refunded to you.
- **In other words, after July 1, 2009 you are responsible for the full tuition, whether or not you attend any classes.**
- **In addition, this tuition is for the Summer 2009 A & P courses only and is not transferable.**
- Your agreement to become a student in this program is a serious financial, as well as personal, commitment. As part of your application process, you are signing this contract agreeing to pay the full amount of the program's tuition, whether or not you complete the course or continue to be an active student in the program.
- **Payments received after due date are subject to a \$50.00 (U.S.) late fee.**

Anatomy and Physiology I is designed to meet the A&P adjunctive requirement for Year 1 & Year 2 students enrolled in the BBSHE Professional Studies Program. Anatomy and Physiology II is a requirement for the Bachelor of Science Degree for students enrolled in the BBSH Degree Program in the United States.
